7.6% increase in the number of passengers inside and outside the cities in 2015/2016

Central Agency for Public Mobilization and Statistics (CAPMAS) issued today /2/2017 Annual Bulletin of public transport for passengers inside and outside the cities 2015/2016. The most important indicators are as follows:

•Number of owned and operated vehicles used for authorities, companies, and public transport facilities:

The number of owned vehicles reached 8.8 thousand vehicles in 2015/2016 (including 2.4 thousand air conditioned vehicles, 6.4 thousand ordinary buses) compared to 9.1 thousand vehicles in 2014/2015, a decrease of 3.5% .

•Number of lines and its total lengths for authorities, companies, and public transport facilities:

- The total number of lines reached 2.5 thousand lines in 2015/2016 compared to 2.7 thousand lines in 2014/2015, a decrease of 9.6 % due to dissolution for some facilities.

- Total line lengths reached 305.3 thousand kilometers in 2015/2016 compared to 307.9 thousand kilometers in 2014/2015, a decrease of 0.9 % .

•Number of lines, its lengths and the number of rounds for subway units:

- The number of lines reached 3 lines 2015/2016 it is same number for previous year.

- lengths of lines reached 76 kilometers 2015/2016 it is same number for previous year.

- The number of rounds for subway units reached 564 thousand rounds in 2015/2016 compared to 565 thousand rounds in 2014/2015, a decrease of 0.2 %.

•Number of lines, its lengths and the number of rounds for operating railway trains:

- The number of lines reached 52 lines in 2015/2016 it is same number for previous year.

- Lengths of lines reached 7.1 thousand kilometers in 2015/2016 it is same number for previous year.

- The number of rounds for operating trains reached 409.5 thousand rounds in 2015/2016 compared to 399.7 thousand rounds in 2014/2015 an increase of 2.4 %.

•The number of passengers inside and outside cities:

- The total number of passengers reached 2.2 billion passengers in 2015/2016 compared to 2.0 billion passengers in 2014/2015 an increase of 7.6 % , the percentage of passengers in vehicles (buses - mini bus) reached 47.0 % , subway 38.9 % , railway 10.9 % , Other means of transport 3.2 % from total in 2015 / 2016.

•The number of passengers of international lines:

- The number of passengers reached 128.8 thousand passengers in 2015/2016 compared to 188.0 thousand passengers in 2014/2015, a decrease of 31.5%, The highest decrease in Cairo - Khartoum line , where the number of passengers reached 2.2 thousand passengers.
